- Work not relating to the learning disabled person.

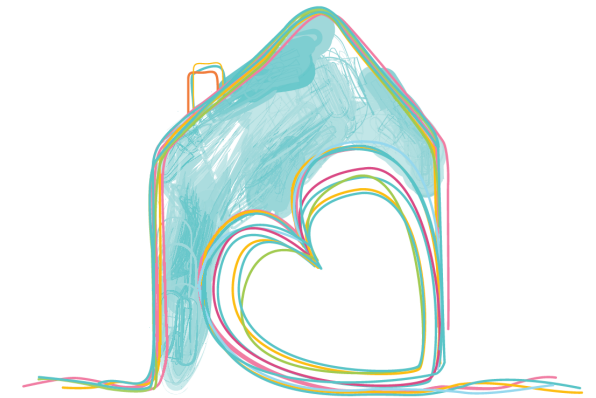

THRIVE is a specialist support service that helps parent carers of young adults aged 19–30 navigate the difficult transition to adulthood, while also supporting older carers of adult children aged 30+ with future care planning, and the challenges of letting go.

We help parents of **young learning disabled adults** with:

- Transitioning from child to adult benefits.
- Further education applications/placements.
- Work placements/day services.
- Independent Living.
